MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The Water System Hearing of the Public Utility District #1 of Jefferson County was opened by the President of the Board of Commissioners at 5:00 p.m. at the District Office, 230 Chimacum Road, Port Hadlock, Washington. Commissioners and staff present were:

Bill Graham, District Resource Manager, remarked that several emails and letters regarding the Water System Plan have been received by the District and all will be added to the documents; the District will address comments that are germane to the Plan itself.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. Ray Harker, Marrowstone Island, asked about any mention in the Plan on decommissioning of wells or reference to any effect not decommissioning wells could have on a saltwater intrusion problem on Marrowstone Island.

The District Manager explained that the PUD has no authority in the decommissioning of wells and that, addressing that Marrowstone issue is premature.

The Manager explained that the District finished drafting the Plan in February, 2004, submitted it to Department of Health, as well as to Jefferson County, for comment. The PUD addressed recommended corrections, then submitted copies

to adjacent water districts. Water District Hearing dates were published. Now the District will review commentary and appendix the Plan, sending it back to the Department of Health, with a Resolution from the Board. Mr. Parker reminded the Board and the public that Water System Plans are continually updated.

There being no further comment from the public, at 5:19 p.m the President closed the Water System Hearing.
