Notice: Regarding the water main break in downtown Port Townsend and State Department of Health “boil order”.

We have been receiving many phone calls about the water line break in downtown Port Townsend that occurred Monday, December 14 and the subsequent boil order issued by the State Department of Health on the same day. This incident is completely unrelated to PUD water or PUD activities. Here are some important facts:

1. If you are a PUD customer, you are not under the boil order.
2. The City of Port Townsend’s water system (distribution) is not connected to any PUD water systems.
3. Adelma Beach, Ocean Grove and Beckett Point are all served by wholesale purchase from the City of Port Townsend at Four Corners. None of these areas listed are affected by the boil order.
4. All PUD water is safe to drink.
