

MISSION STATEMENT
PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, WASHINGTON

Acting under the authority of 54.04. RCW, which authorizes “the establishment of public utility districts to conserve the water and power resources of the State of Washington for the benefit of the people thereof, and to supply public utility service, including water and electricity for all uses.”, the Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the following mission statement:

- a. To promote the conservation of water and power resources within Jefferson County.
- b. To provide wastewater management and water services to the citizens of Jefferson County, within the parameters established by governing statutes, at the lowest possible cost, consistent with legitimate concerns for protection of the environment, when such services cannot be provided by the private sector
- c. To identify the water requirements and ground and surface water resources of Jefferson County.
- d. To protect and preserve the quality of agricultural and industrial water supplies in Jefferson
- e. To identify and preserve the renewable power resources of Jefferson County for the benefit of the citizens thereof.
- f. To carry out the responsibilities of the Satellite System Management Agency for Jefferson County as defined by the Coordinated Water Service Plan.
- g. To strive for the highest degree of public involvement in all District activities.
- h. To develop and implement effective managerial, administrative and fiscal policies and procedures to insure that the District provides the most efficient and cost-effective services possible to the citizens of Jefferson County.
