Within the resolution, the reason(s) requiring the need to draw down funds will be stated; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Public Utility District No. 1 of Jefferson County establishes the following as reasons to draw down funds from the established Line of Credit with CFC; reasons include storm related damages, natural disaster, or extraordinary unexpected expenses.
