#### 1. Call to Order.

Commissioner Dan Toepper called the special joint meeting of the Citizen Advisory Board (CAB) and the PUD Board of Commissioners (BOC) for May 10, 2021, to order at 2:02 p.m.

All commissioners were present, and a quorum was established of the BOC. Chair Jessica Dillon of the CAB called for roll call of the CAB and a quorum was established,

**MOTION:** CAB member Gary Rowe made a motion to adopt the agenda as revised. CAB member Dan Taylor seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

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- **4. Public Comment.** Chair Jessica Dillon read the guidelines for public comment. No public comment.
- **5. Gordon Wilson presentation.** Gordon Wilson, Senior Program Manager with FCS Group gave a presentation. A Project Plan was provided as an attachment online with the agenda. There was considerable discussion. Further details can be heard on the audio recording at <a href="https://www.jeffpud.org">www.jeffpud.org</a>. It was the consensus of the group that Gordon Wilson of FCS Group will be coming back to the BOC and the CAB with an evaluation that looks at four different alternatives and the pluses and minuses of each alternative and make a recommendation to the BOC of what FCS Group thinks is the preferred option. The four alternatives are as follows:
  - Status Quo.
  - Full Meter Replacement with Manual Read System.
  - Full Meter Replacement with AMR System.
  - Full Meter Replacement with AMI System.
- **6. Communications.** Chair Jessica Dillon and CAB members discussed emails that had been received by the Chair. There was a suggestion that the Operating Guidelines should include that the Chair of the CAB would be the recipient of all emails and respond accordingly.
- 7. GM Report. This item was done after the BOC Update. General Manager Kevin Streett gave a report on broadband. PUD staff is working on grants on the water systems. A new LUD in Shine was formed.
- **8. BOC Update. This item was taken out of the line-up.** Commissioner Dan Toepper and Commissioner Jeff Randall gave a report. Commissioner Kenneth Collins left the meeting at 4:00 p.m.
  - Rate study is ending.
  - PUD has initiated water increases.
  - Looking at sewer rate schedules.
  - Near completion of rates on the electric side.
  - Two clean audits accountability and financial.
  - Financial dashboards up on the website.
  - Board allocated the General Manager to spend \$200,000 on engineering and grant writing towards broadband.
  - PUD continues to participate with the city, county, and the port on the Intergovernmental Collaborative Group (ICG).
  - EDC (Economical Developmental Council) report.
  - Update on low-income rates.
