BACKGROUND: After nearly a year of work, JPUD and Finley Engineering have completed design engineering for our grant funded fiber to the premises construction project extending from Mt. Walker north to Gardiner and Chimacum.

JPUD is now looking to contract all underground construction and splicing work on our combined Olympic Fiber Corridor and Inbetweens projects. Once connected with the aerial fiber currently being installed by JPUD's line crew, this project would complete the fiber buildout to approx. 1,288 homes and businesses in rural Quilcene, Discovery Bay, Gardiner, and Chimacum by Nov 30th, 2024. Construction is estimated to begin in late February or early March.

The Invitation to Bid for Olympic Corridor and In-Betweens Fiber Construction Project Bid No. **23BB0803** was previously reviewed and approved to form by representatives of the Washington State Broadband Office. Per our procurement manual, JPUD's elected Commission must be petitioned for approval to publish invitations to bid on Public Works Projects over \$350,000.

FISCAL IMPACT: The Engineer's Estimate for Olympic Corridor and In-Betweens Fiber Construction Project Bid No. 23BB0803 is \$11.3M.

Total estimated combined project cost is \$21.5M. \$11.5M in grant funding comes from federal award number 53-08-12209 (BIP NTIA) awarded to Washington State Broadband Office by the U.S. Department of the Commerce. \$6M in funding comes from federal award number SLRFP0002 (ARPA SLFRF) or CPFFN0145 (ARPA Capital) awarded to Washington State Broad Band Office by the U.S. Department of the Treasury.

Sealed bids will be received by the PUD No. 1 of Jefferson County, located at 310 Four Corners Rd., Port Townsend, WA 98368, until 3 p.m. Pacific Time, January 31, 2024, for the general contract for construction of broadband fiber construction in the District's Olympic Corridor. Bidder shall provide a hard copy of all documents to be submitted in the bid package. In addition, the Bidder shall also include a USB memory stick with a copy of their bid in electronic searchable PDF format. The Unit Pricing Table within the Bid Proposal Form shall be in the original Excel Spreadsheet file structure.

The project consists of constructing approximately 78.79 miles of buried mainline fiber and 47.87 miles of buried drop fiber to 1,470 establishments in the Owner's newly defined Exchanges of Gardiner and Quilcene. Fiber placement will be accomplished through the use of directional boring conduit and pulling the fiber into the conduit or through the use of cable plows capable of knifing conduit or fiber below the surface. Structure placement will include above grade pedestals and at grade fiber optic hand holds. The Owner will be placing new aerial fiber optic plant that will tie into the fiber placed under this contract. The successful Contractor will need to coordinate with the Owner's aerial crew to facilitate leaving the appropriate coils at aerial to buried transition points. This project will include fiber optic splicing for both the aerial and buried splice locations.
