A RESOLUTION Adopting a Budget for the Calendar Year 2011

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 54.16.070 and RCW 84.52.020, the Board of Commissioners of Public Utility District No.1 of Jefferson County, Washington has prepared a budget for the projected financial transactions of the District for the calendar year 2011 and conducted a series of Public Hearings; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the District did approve a six year rate schedule on 21 November 2007, Resolution 2007-014; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the District did meet on Monday, October 4, 2010 and held a Public Hearing on the proposed 2011 budget starting at 5:00 p.m. in the District Office at 230 Chimacum Road, Port Hadlock, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing was continued and reconvened at the subsequent regularly scheduled PUD BOC meetings, as announced publicly by the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing was continued and closed by the PUD Board of Commissioners on the 3rd of November, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission, after taking public testimony and consideration of all the evidence and information provided by the staff, hereby adopts the budget identified on attached Exhibit "A" and confirms the updated rate schedule identified on attached Exhibit "B".

For meters and related appurtenances installed by the District, including road crossings, the following charges shall be levied and collected at the time of service application:

5/8" x 3/4"	\$1,500.00

Installation of service lines and meters which exceed 2" will be contracted and paid for by the customer/developer.

For installation of meter only the following charges shall apply*:

5/8" x 3/4" (Sealed register)	PUD Cost of meter including S & H
1"	PUD Cost of meter including S & H
11/2"	PUD Cost of meter including S & H
2" (Compound)	PUD Cost of meter including S & H

^{*} costs will be updated every 6 months, costs will be rounded up to nearest 10 dollar increment.

Charges for the installation of only a meter apply when the service connection and all associated valves, fittings, meter yoke, etc. have already been installed in accordance with the District's specifications, at the expense of the property owner. Increasing the size of the setter assembly will cost an additional \$200 dollars. Service connections over 2" will be installed by a contractor or developer
