**RESOLUTION NO. 2012-027**

A RESOLUTION Adopting a Budget for the Calendar Year 2013

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 54.16.070 and RCW 84.52.020, the Board of Commissioners of Public Utility District No.1 of Jefferson County, Washington has prepared a budget for the projected financial transactions of the District for the calendar year 2013 and conduct a series of Public Hearings; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the District did approve a six year rate schedule on 21 November 2007, Resolution 2007-014; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the District did meet on Monday, October 1 2012 and held a Public Hearing on the proposed 2012 budget starting at 5:00 p.m. in the District Office at 230 Chimacum Road, Port Hadlock, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing was continued and reconvened at the subsequent regularly scheduled PUD BOC meetings, as announced publicly by the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing was continued and closed by the PUD Board of Commissioners on the 6th of November 2012; and

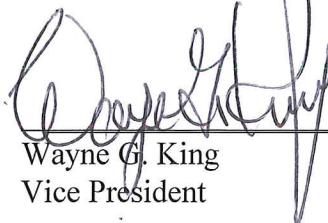
WHEREAS, after review of the 2013 proposed Budget the PUD Board felt that the six year rate schedule approved in Resolution 2007-014 could be postponed for one year.

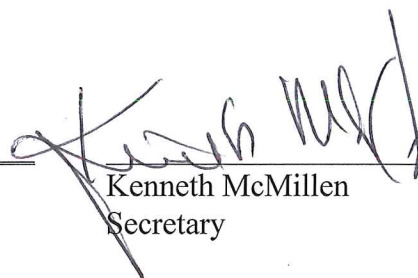
